Week 1 – March 27 to March 31st, 2023 – 5-day Camp

For Children P5 – M1

- **BZS Rangers Camp is a 5-day camp – cost \$325.00. This Camp will be an out-in-nature experience with anticipated extended time outdoors and learning Survivor Skills. This Camp would benefit a child that enjoys the outdoors and nature.**

Camp runs 9:00 AM -3:00 PM (Early drop-off 8:30 AM, pick-up by 3:15PM) with one Overnight Camping on Trunk Island – Sleeping in a shelter that was built or option to sleep indoors.

- **This Camp is available only to active members of the Bermuda Zoological Society (BZS) or the Atlantic Conservation Partnership (ACP). Membership may be purchased at the time of application (see page 3).** The parents of the child(ren) (re)applying must have a minimum of a Killifish (Family) membership. Your membership must be **current** (i.e., valid until December 31, 2023). If you are not a member, please complete the Membership Application form on Page 3. It would be giving you a membership until December 2023.
- Rangers Camp fee and membership fee may be included in the same payment.
